



Emergent Phenomena in Correlated Quantum Matter – Summer School

ICAM Cargese Summer School 2019

In August of 2019 (August 5 - August 17), ICAM had a two-week Summer School in Cargese, Corsica (France), entitled Emergent Phenomena in Correlated Quantum Matter (EPICQUR). This school featured 12 lecturers and about 70 students from 17 countries. The students came from four continents (Europe, North America, Asia and Africa). About two thirds of the students were theory students while the remaining third were experimental students. The ratio of male to female students was roughly 2:1. Most lecturers and organizers stayed for the entire duration of the conference allowing the students to interact closely with them and get additional tutorial help on various topics as needed. Two afternoons were devoted to poster sessions where a total of 40 students presented posters. There were also two excursions organized by the school - a Bus trip to Piana and Porto, and a Boat trip from Cargese harbor around the island of Corsica to further enrich the experience of the school.
